PRIMARY SPORT FACILITIES

Abbotsford has a wide diversity of both traditional and unique sport facilities.

Abbotsford Recreation Centre

This facility has the ability to handle a variety of summer and winter sporting events.

- 25m pool (7 lanes) / Olympic size rink
- 5 curling sheets / seats 375 spectators

Matsqui Recreation Centre

Conveniently located in the centre of town, this facility can host hockey and figure skating events.

- 1 rink / seats 475 spectators

MSA Arena

This arena is home to the Abbotsford Pilots and is a great addition to the list of ice rinks in Abbotsford.

- 1 rink / seats 800 spectators

Abbotsford Centre Ice (Private Rink)

As the only twin arena in Abbotsford, Centre Ice is a great place to hold multi-division tournaments.

- 2 rinks / seats 500 spectators

Abbotsford Curling Rink

The dedicated staff and volunteers are committed to providing outstanding experiences through bonspiels and championships.

Abbotsford Entertainment & Sports Centre

The Entertainment and Sports Centre is the largest single indoor gathering space for both the city and the Fraser Valley.

BMX Track

- Concrete starter pad / Asphalt finish line
- Pneumatic electronically-controlled gate
- 1100 ft. long track with dirt jumps and obstacles

- 2 meeting rooms (1 banquet hall)

Rotary Stadium & Track

Part of Exhibition Park, this premier sports field, is one of the best track surfaces within British Columbia

- 400 m, eight-lane, rubberized track (grass infield)
- 123,047 sq.ft grass infield
- Seats 4000 spectators (3000 covered)
- PA system, timing tower & fieldhouse
